

Transition of Care - Medication Reconciliation Post Discharge (TRC-MRP)

Measure Description

The percentage of discharges from January 1st to December 1st of the measurement year for members 18 years of age and older for whom medications were reconciled within 30 days after discharge.

- The measure is a weight of **(0.5)** star and is part of the **STARs P4P Incentive Program**.
- If a discharge is followed by a readmission or direct transfer within 30 days of the discharge, medication reconciliation is only needed for the last discharge.

Call to Action

- ✓ **Contact all patients** who have been **recently discharged from an inpatient setting**.
- ✓ **Determine** who contacts the member, when are they contacted, how is your office notified of a discharge, how soon should the discharged member be seen for follow up.
- ✓ **Ensure** outpatient records **list the reconciled medications** and **specify reconciliation was performed post-discharge**.
- ✓ **Submit** the CPT II code 1111F with a **date of service that is within 30 days of the date of discharge** to ensure reconciliation is **compliant**.

Documentation Requirements

Inpatient discharge must be followed by medication reconciliation of the current and discharge medications conducted by a pre-scribing practitioner, clinical pharmacist or registered nurse within 30 days after discharge. Any of the following meets criteria:

- Current medication list with a notation which states the clinician reconciled the current and discharge medications.
- Current medication list with a notation that references the discharge medications.
- Current medication list with a notation which states that the discharge medications were reviewed.
- Current and discharge medication lists with a notation stating both were reviewed on the same date of service.
- Current medication list with evidence that the member was seen for hospital post-discharge follow-up along with evidence of a completed medication review.
- Notation that no medications were prescribed or ordered upon discharge.

Code for Reporting

CPT II Code

1111F - Discharge medications and current medications reconciled
(The submission of this code helps to meet HEDIS requirements, diminishing the need for additional chart pulls.)
